
Performing the NFHS Finals Cut and Reorder


Note: The event must be setup as type "2007 NFHS 1M 11-Diving P/S/F Format"

Note: Do not close the connection to the timing console before starting this procedure.

1. Complete scoring on rounds 1 through 8, and the move to Round 9 Diver 1.



2. From the Run Meet Center menu, choose NFHS Finals Cut and Reorder.



3. Confirm the number of places advancing to finals. If you are using a Master Event, this is the number of places advancing to finals for each individual event within the Master Event. When

ready, click the **Cut and Reorder** button.

- 5. If you need to update a timing console, select the directions below for your timing console.
 - a. For CTS 6 v1.2 and higher:
 - i. On the CTS 6, return to the Choose Event screen (accessible from the Change Event button).
 - ii. Click the Send to Console button in MKD.
 - iii. Data will be automatically sent to the CTS 6. A message will appear on the CTS 6 screen during the transmission. At the conclusion of the transmission, the CTS 6

screen will momentarily display "New data has been stored", and Meet Keeper will display:



- iv. Click **OK** to clear the message from Meet Keeper Diving.
- v. On the CTS 6, choose the new event just uploaded (it is usually the last one on the list, and will only have 3 rounds). Proceed using this event, for the final 3 rounds of diving, configuring any additional CTS settings (board, gender, judges), along the way. Click "Run Event" to resume the event in the CTS 6.
- vi. NOTE: Rounds 9 11 will display as rounds 1 3 in the new event.
- b. For CTS 5:
 - i. On the CTS 5, return to the Stored Data screen.
 - ii. Click the Send to Console button in MKD.
 - iii. When prompted, press the Import Data button on the CTS 5, followed by the OK button in Meet Keeper Diving. Data will then be sent to the CTS 5.

iv. At the conclusion of the transmission, the CTS 5 screen will display "Press Next Dive Key to Run Meet", and Meet Keeper will display:



- v. On the CTS 5, press the Next Dive key to resume the new event. Proceed using this event, for the final 3 rounds of diving, configuring any additional CTS settings (board, gender, judges), along the way.
- vi. NOTE: Rounds 9 11 will display as rounds 1 3 in the new event.
- c. For Daktronics Standalone:
 - i. On the Dak console, be sure that memory areas C and D are empty. Consult your Daktronics manual if you are unclear on performing this procedure.
 - ii. Click the Send to Console button in MKD.
 - iii. After the process completes, the operator needs to switch memory area C.Make sure that memory area C is at Diver #1 Round #1.
 - iv. NOTE: Rounds 9 11 will display as rounds 1-3 on the console.
 - NOTE: Total Scores are reset to 0 on the console, so the totals for each diver will be incorrect on the console and/or scoreboard, but will be correct in Meet Keeper – Diving. This is a limitation of the Daktronics protocol, not our software.
 - vi. NOTE: If the Finals contains more than 25 divers, divers 26 to 50 will appear in memory area D.
